6G: a new global framework



Important changes since 5G early days (~2012)

Geopolitics:

- Cybersecurity and strategic importance of connectivity platforms
- Amplified by recent crises
 - → EU: Reinforced need to *address a complete supply chain*, including micro-electronics (Chips Act)

Industry:

- Regional policies to reconstruct a strategic industry
- Set of new players (incl. hyperscalers) in the wake of software/cloud/open interfaces
 - → EU: Need to consolidate its *leadership with cloud and edge supply capabilities*

Sustainability/Societal:

- Emerges as top priority, both from industrial and policy side
- Climate change, but not only
- Security, accessibility, affordability...
 - → EU: Strong *links with other policies*, eg. Green Deal

Users

- New business models and value chains
- Rising importance of verticals and users beyond classical MNOs
 - → EU: Address a *holistic perspective* from the onset (not add on)










